EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP POLICIESJUNE 1, 2021

- 1. The UMW scholarship shall be awarded to a youth or adult member or constituent of the First United Methodist Church (FUMC) of Carson City.
- 2. The amount of the scholarship(s) shall be designated by the FUMC UMW before the scholarship is awarded.
- 3. The UMW scholarship shall be applied to any accredited institution of higher learning. Please provide name and address of the specific institution as scholarship will be sent to that school.
- 4. The UMW scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of scholarship ability, financial need, and past and present involvement in the activities of the FUMC of Carson City.
- 5. The UMW scholarship recipient shall be selected by the UMW Scholarship Committee.
- 6. An alternate shall be selected by the UMW Scholarship Committee. The alternate may receive the scholarship should the recipient not register at an accredited institution of high learning or drop out of school after the first semester of study.
- 7. Half the UMW scholarship amount shall be paid upon registration for the semester; the remaining half shall be paid upon registration for the following semester.
- 8. The UMW scholarship recipient shall maintain at least a 2.5 GPA. An official transcript of the first semester grades and GPA shall be returned to First United Methodist Church at 400 W. King St, Suite 100, Carson City, NV 89703 ~ Attention UMW. Should the recipient not maintain this average in the first semester of study, the UMW Scholarship committee shall review the case and determine whether to renew the scholarship for the second semester. Circumstances shall be reviewed in the event an alternate grading system is used by the institution of high learning. A review shall also be conducted in the event of illness, which may cause the recipient to drop out of school.
- 9. The UMW scholarship shall be used by the recipient during the school year for which it is awarded. Should it not be used during the year for which it is awarded, the balance will be forfeited by the recipient and cannot be reclaimed at a future date.
- 10. The UMW scholarship may not be awarded to the same recipient for more than two (2) years.
- 11. Late or incomplete applications WILL NOT be considered.
